

Transport / Traveling with weapons

Weapons must always be checked in and are subject to additional charges.

Transport of weapons must be requested and approved in advance. You can request transport of weapons up to 24 hours before departure. In you have booked your trip through a travel agency, you must contact the travel agency for assistance.

If you have weapons and ammunition with you, you must confirm the following:

- You have a valid gun license or a service card from an authority (must be presented at the check-in desk and on arrival when you retrieve the weapon).
- That the weapon is unloaded and unusable during transport, divided into vital part and other part or provided with a weapon lock.
- Ammunition is classified as dangerous goods and must be transported in original packaging that protects from hard shocks/blows (must be packaged in a secure way). Ammunition (i.e., only cartridges 1.4S UN 0012 or UN 0014) with a gross weight of a maximum of 5 kilos per person for own use may be carried on board the flight. Ammunition must be packed in separately checked baggage and not in the same bag as the weapon or weapon parts.

You must check in at least one hour before departure to complete the necessary paperwork and pass the security checks.
